Dear Presidents, dear Friends,

Following earlier correspondence, I would like to remind you that the 27th European Youth Bridge Team Championships will be held at the Oslofjord Convention Centre in Stokke.

Format of the Championships

The Championships consist of four Series: U26 Open, U26 Women, U21 and U16. Subject to the number of entries in the respective Series they are expected to be played as complete Round-Robins.

Right to enter

Each member NBO is authorized to enter one team in each series. NBOs must have paid the entry fee and be up to date with the payment of dues (including 2019 dues) to the EBL before they can participate in the Championship.

Each participating NBO must play against all the other NBOs. Entry and subsequent refusal to play will result in disqualification.

Every proposed player must, along with other criteria, satisfy the Credentials Committee that:

a. he/she is nominated by the NBO of the country of his/her birth or the NBO of which such nominated player first became a member, and has not, during the current or immediately



- preceding calendar year, represented a different NBO in any WBF competition or any zonal or intra-zonal competition; or
- b. he/she is nominated by the NBO of the country of his/her citizenship or bona fide residence and has not, during the current or immediately preceding two calendar years, represented a different NBO in any WBF competition or any zonal or intra-zonal competition; and
- c. to participate in the U26 Open & U26 Women Series a player must have been born on or after 1st January 1994, to participate in the U21 Series a player must have been born on or after 1st January 1999 and to participate in the U16 Series a player must have been born on or after 1st January 2004.

Registration of teams

The entries to the Championships must be submitted electronically, via the EBL Website (not by email) starting today until **22**nd **May 2019** the latest (it is very important that this deadline is respected) at

Entry fees

The entry fees are € 1,000 for the U26 Open, € 600 for the U26 Women and € 800 for the U21.

A discount will be given to the countries who did not participate in the last two EBL Youth Team Championships held in Tromsø 2015 and in Šamorín 2017: for these teams the entry fees are € 500 for the U26 Open, € 300 for the U26 Women and € 400 for the U21.

No entry fee to be paid for the U16 Series.
